Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> March Association Trials for 13/U & 14/U was completed and 2 teams for each grade chosen.

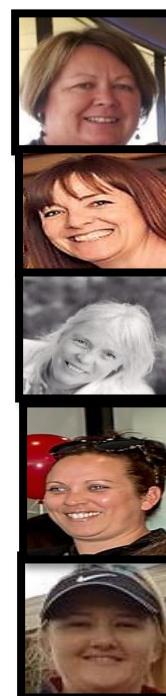
1 Open team selected, 1 team 14U Boys and 1 team No Limits.
