### COVID-19 VIRUS STRICTENS THE WORLD

Email sent out to all clubs to inform their members with regards to our 2020 winter season. Meeting held with Netball WA and all Presidents from all the Associations that all Netball WA Members should have received an email from the CEO.

Considering this information which states all regular winter competitions are to be delayed to the 30<sup>th</sup> May 2020 and any trainings and grading to be postponed.

SDNA has confirmed to all their members that their winter season will be adjusted to a 10-week season (playing every team twice in your grade) and a 3-week final series, commencing on Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> June 2020 and playing through to Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> August 2020. Finals will stay as originally set.

SDNA portion of the fees will be discounted by \$30.00 (a third). Please note the Netball WA fee is an Annual fee that will cover you from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2020 – 31<sup>st</sup> December 2020 and the City of Gosnells' portion is per season.

Teams and clubs may start their training on or after the 30<sup>th</sup> May 2020, providing you comply with Government regulations and guidelines stated above. We will continue to communicate any changes as The COVID-19 situation evolves.

The Australian Health Department Suggest that the best way to prevent infection is to avoid being exposed To the virus. This can be done by following the everyday preventative actions for protecting against respiratory infections such as:

Plan B – Commence Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> July 2020 – 10 weeks with Top 1 & 2 Grand Final Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> September, 2020.

## Reduction in Fees.

Southern Districts have already discounted players SDNA fee of \$30.00 we they decided to make it a 10-week Winter season.

Today Netball WA have released their new fee structure –

Senior First Competition Fee (Winter) \$67.00 instead of \$90.00

Junior First Competition Fee (Winter) \$66.00 instead of \$86.00

If 2020 members continue to play Spring a second competition fee will be charged of \$11.00 for both Seniors and Juniors.

Suncorp NetSetGo Fees – As per NWA memo sent to clubs on 28<sup>th</sup> May 2020.

The Netball WA Board agreed that the Suncorp NetSetGo participant fees will remain unchanged as outlined and Appendix B.

Primary Participants fee \$63.40 (GST Incl.) This primary fee is inclusive of the Netball WA Fee of \$37.00 (GST Inc.) and Netball Australia Participation fee of \$23.00 (GST incl.)

## Withdrawal of Teams and Players

Please advise SDNA before the 15<sup>th</sup> June if your club wishes to de-register players or teams for this season.

Payment of Fees – Invoicing clubs will commence once we confirm the start of our season. No payment Required at present.

Training – Courts still available in the current format limited timeslots across Monday – Wednesday evenings.

Lights on courts 15 – 22 will be completed by middle of June when they are up and running, we will have further zones for training.

All forms are required to be submitted to SDNA prior to 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020 for all your teams training, this includes fitness sessions at local parks and any other venues – this is a requirement from NWA>

The latest schedule for the floodlighting, the 8 x light fittings are due for Langford on the 28<sup>th</sup> of May and will be ready for the 4 x light poles coming either Friday 29<sup>th</sup> May or Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> June.
