Masks are mandatory and must be always worn at all times when you leave your residence. Inside venues limited to twenty people, outside venue limited to 150 people with all places that you visit, you must register on the Safe WA app or on a register supplied.

Starting 6:00pm, Friday 5 February  
until 12:01am, Sunday 14 February

NOTE: the South West will return immediately to pre-lockdown conditions at 6:00pm Friday 5 February

Under WA's post-lockdown transition plan, stay-at-home rules will be lifted, but the following interim restrictions will apply:

<b>Businesses &amp; venues</b> All businesses and venues which closed can re-open, except for the following restrictions: Playground not reopen. The 4 square metre capacity rule will be in place for most venues. Maximum of 150 people apply to: - public and hospital, entertainment and fitness venues (excluding golf) - people's meetings and funerals (except for community events) Social service may recommence for hospital venues. Dancing only permitted for weddings and special events.	<b>Private gatherings</b> Private indoor and outdoor gatherings limited to 20 people. <b>Masks</b> Masks required in public, including at work, school, for vigorous outdoor recreation or in transit. <b>Health and Aged Care</b> Elective surgery will return to normal arrangements. Visitors and clinical students permitted at hospitals. Visitors aged and disability facilities remain restricted to compassionate services.
<b>Schools</b> Schools will reopen. Term 1 of WA public schools will commence Monday 8 February. Masks required for staff of all schools, and for students in secondary schools. Masks are not required for primary school students. Teachers may remove masks while conducting a class.	<b>Travel</b> Leaving the Perth-Peel region is restricted to essential purposes, make for work purposes (permitted, including for FIFO workers). People leaving the Perth-Peel region are limited to one interstate trip 14 February.

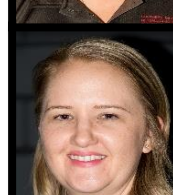

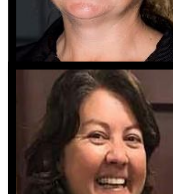
