

UPDATING COACHING ACCREDITATION GUIDELINES

Coaching accreditation is current for four (4) years from the date achieved. If you complete the next level of accreditation during this 4 year period, your timeline restarts and your new accreditation is valid for the next 4 years. Netball Australia allows a 6-month grace period to obtain these points should your accreditation expire.

Why Update?

Updating provides an opportunity for coaches to:

- Keep your accreditation current and therefore valid.
- Keep up with the latest information on developments within netball.
- Receive the latest general and specific safety information for netball.
- Have the most up to date techniques and coaching methods in Australia.

How many points do I need to update my accreditation?

Netball Australia requires a coach to reach the specified number of points of updating activity for each accreditation level as listed below:

Foundation Accreditation	Attain Development OR Complete 20 points in 4 years
Development Accreditation	Attain Intermediate OR Complete 40 points in 4 years
Intermediate Accreditation	Attain Advanced OR Complete 60 points in 4 years
Advanced Accreditation	Attain Elite OR Complete 80 points in 4 years
Elite Accreditation	Attain High Performance OR Complete 100 points in 4 years
High Performance Accreditation	Complete 120 points in 4 years

How to Update your Accreditation

We have a new way to learn netball at the brand-new Netball Learning Centre. Head to <https://learning.netball.com.au> to get started.

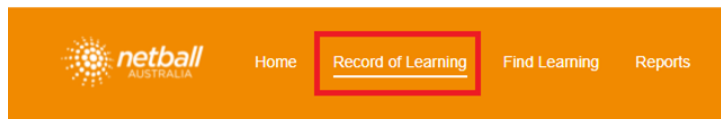
If you are an existing learner, you can reset your password by following the reset password prompts and entering the email you use from your MyNetball account.

What do I need to renew?

You need to organise and check your status of certification before it is due for renewal. If you are not sure when your renewal date is, you should check your certification records.

How do I check my due date?

To view your certifications once logged into Netball Learning, select the Record of Learning tab up the top of the page.



Select **Certifications**.

Record of Learning : All Certifications



You may notice that in the Certifications table, the **Certification due date** is different to the **Expiration date**, as shown in the screenshot below. This is due to the 6 month grace period that has been applied to Certifications, and has been provided to learners to account for the interruptions as described above.

The **Certification due date** is the original due date for the certification, before the 6 month extension has been applied. The **Expiration date** contains the updated due date that accounts for the extension and you will have until that date to complete any learning items that are a part of the re-certification pathway. This may include registering practical

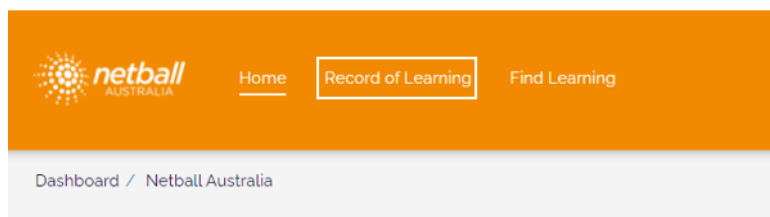
coaching or umpiring hours, as well as achieving the required number of points for that Certification through the completion of online and face to face courses or workshops.

How long will this Grace Period remain for?

All Certifications with a due date on or before the 30th of April will have the 6 month Grace Period applied. Any Certifications due after this date will not have this extension applied, and the due date and expiry dates will remain the same.

Progressing through the Recertification Pathway

Once logged in to your Netball Learning account, select the **Record of Learning** heading at the top of the page.



From here, select the **Certifications** tab, and then the **Certification name** of the desired accreditation. In this scenario, we'll be selecting the Development Coach Accreditation.

Once in the Development Coach Accreditation, scrolling down to around the halfway mark of the page will take us to the Recertification Path section. This is where we can enrol in courses to maintain our current accreditation. As highlighted below, there is generally a **Mandatory course** involving some form of practical development within the relevant field (in this case, 20 hours of Coaching). Select the **Launch course** button next to the desired course's name to go to that course.

Practical Coaching - Development - 20 hours

Description

In addition to a range of updating activities, to successfully update a Development Coach accreditation, a coach must complete a minimum of 20 hours of on court coaching throughout the four-year updating period. Practical coaching includes training and game day coaching which can be undertaken with any level of athlete or team or official and may occur on a regular basis (weekly, fortnightly) or in specific situations such as camps, clinics.

Must hold a current Development Coach Accreditation.

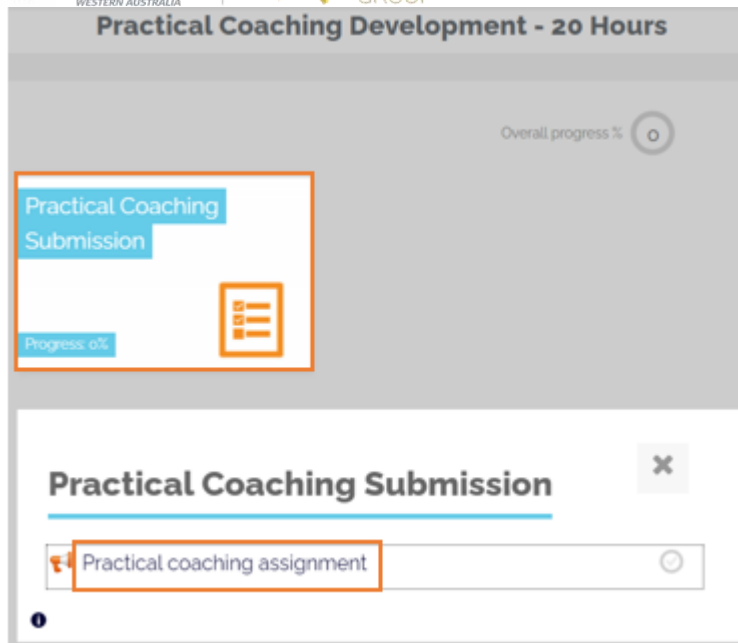
