Team Selectors

Southern Districts Netball Association (SDNA) is calling for Expressions of Interest from experienced and passionate selectors to be part of the trial and selection process for our 2026 Representative Teams.

The trial process will take place in February 2026, with selectors playing a vital role in identifying talented athletes and supporting their development through the SDNA Representative Program.

To be considered, selectors must:

- Hold a minimum Development Level Coaching Accreditation.
- Have experience in netball development and talent identification.
- Be available for all 2026 trial and squad dates (available on the SDNA website).
- Demonstrate the ability to view athletes objectively and without bias.
- Work collaboratively with other selectors and the SDNA Development Officer.
- Have completed the Select for Netball Success course (available via the Netball Learning Centre).

Head Coaches

Applicants for Head Coach positions must hold a Development Level Coaching Accreditation or higher. We are seeking a range of Coaches who can bring different skill sets to our program, including:

- Ability to drive intensity and performance.
- Strong technical and tactical knowledge.
- Ability to work collaboratively in a team environment.
- Commitment to developing athletes along the SDNA and NWA pathways.
- Availability to attend team selections, training, and match play as scheduled.
- Willingness to liaise with the Association Development Officer, Assistant Coaches, SDNA Administration, and Uniform Convenor.

Assistant Coaches

Applicants for Assistant Coach positions must hold a Foundation Level Coaching Accreditation or higher. We are seeking enthusiastic individuals who are eager to learn and develop their coaching experience within the SDNA Representative Program:

- Support the Head Coach in planning and delivery of sessions.
- Assist in developing players along the SDNA and NWA pathways.
- Work collaboratively with the Head Coach, Development Officer, SDNA Administration, and Uniform Convenor.

All Selectors and Coaches must hold a current Working with Children Card and be a registered Netball WA Member.
